Welcome to CAFT's new authentication process

Originators should have arrived at this screen via a secure link provided through your credit union online banking account, or by directly inputting the correct CAFT URL: caft.paymentsanytime.com.

If you have any doubt regarding the legitimacy of a web page or communication, always contact your credit union directly before clicking on any links.

To all CAFT users, please note the login process to the CAFT platform has been enhanced to now include multifactor authentication (MFA). This will help increase security and deter unauthorized access to CAFT Originator User Accounts.

Getting started

MFA will require additional steps to your existing login process, particularly if this is your first time signing in with MFA.

To begin the process, simply click on the link at the bottom of the page. It will lead you to the MFA login screen where you will be prompted through a series of steps including the download of an authenticator app to set up your MFA account.


- The first thing you will notice is Welcome to CAFT's new authentication process bulletin.

• Click the **link** at the bottom of the bulletin as shown in the picture.








 Once you click the link, you will be asked to enter your username and password.









• After you enter your username and password, Click **Continue.**







• It is possible that you will be asked to reset your password at this time.







 To reset your password. Enter your old password. Followed by your new password and confirm by re-typing your new password.







 Once you are done with your password. Click Change Password








 With your new password set you may want to manage your password with an automated tool.









• You will require a QR code scanner on your authentication app.








• Open your authenticator App and scan the QR code.








• Once you scan your QR code secure the recovery code.








• Be sure to capture and keep your recovery code in a safe location.







 Once you captured your recovery code, check the box I have safely recorded the code.

• Click Continue.
